Recent heavy rains have resulted in a culvert failure on IL 267, north of Greenfield. This steel culvert was installed in 1939 and has rusted through both the top and bottom walls, creating a large void next to the edge of the highway. The contractor will remove and replace the culvert, install flared end sections and riprap on the culvert ends for protection and patch the highway pavement with a PCC patch. Excavation is to be benched and work is to be staged.


