Description of services and/or supplies to be provided:

Immediate expenditure is necessary for repairs to State property to protect against further loss or damage. As a result of a winter with extreme freeze/thaw cycles and excessive moisture we have experienced an excessive amount of potholes and pavement deterioration. These conditions are creating a traffic hazard causing vehicles to have tire blowouts or swerve into adjacent lanes potentially causing accidents. We have had numerous complaints/claims.
District - 7 is requesting an emergency skip patching and resurfacing project in Macon County:
1) US 51 (0.1 Mi N of Forsyth Rd to I-72 in Decatur)
2) IL 121 (from South city limit of Mt. Zion north to US36)
3) IL 121(22nd St) - Locust St. To Garfield

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

